

SRJC Foundation Ag Trust Scholarships Available for 2023

The SRJC Foundation Ag Trust Committee recently approved **up to eight \$1,500 scholarships** for graduating high school seniors planning to attend SRJC in the fall 2023 semester with a major in Agriculture or Natural Resource Management. The scholarships are targeted to students who have been active in 4H or FFA and want to pursue a two or four year degree leading to a career in agriculture. The SRJC Ag Trust Committee has developed a streamlined application process which will focus on the applicants agricultural experience, leadership, community service and academic success in high school.

The SRJC Agriculture/Natural Resources Department is the logical starting point for local students to establish a pathway to a successful career in agriculture. The Ag/NR Department provides Certificate Programs, Associates Degrees and Transfer Programs to the most popular universities in the country. Nine individual programs are offered ranging from agribusiness and animal science to sustainable agriculture and viticulture with exit points leading to various levels of employment.
