A. Phase One

B. Phase Two

The Ag Trust Scholarship Committee will review the personal statements and transcripts of all applicants to determine which applicants to interview. Applicants may be asked to submit additional information prior to the interview. All applicants will be notified of the results of the committees work once the process is completed.
